

The regular meeting of the East Feliciana Parish Police Jury was called to order on August 2, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. by Police Jury President Louis Kent. President Kent offered an opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Jason McCray.

The roll was called by Parish Secretary Yamesha Harris and the following jurors were present: Mr. Michael Cheatham, Mr. Kyle Fleniken, Mr. Chris Hall (via Zoom), Mr. Ronald Johnson, Mr. Louis Kent, Mr. Jason McCray, Mr. Richard Oliveaux, and Dr. Chrissie O'Quin. Mr. Keith Mills was absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Jason McCray, seconded by Vice President Chrissie O'Quin, to approve the agenda and move the visitors up. This motion passed unanimously without comment.

A motion was made by Vice President Chrissie O'Quin, seconded by Mr. Michael Cheatham, to adopt the minutes from the July 19, 2021 Regular Meeting. This motion passed.

A motion was made by Vice President Chrissie O'Quin, seconded by Mr. Michael Cheatham, to approve Blanco Brothers Construction estimate #1924 for repairs to Voters Machine Warehouse in the amount of \$25,825.00. This motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Richard Oliveaux, seconded by Mr. Jason McCray, to approve preliminary map for Green Meadows Estates East Subdivision. This motion passed. A Public Hearing was held on August 2, 2021 at 5:30pm to receive input from the public.

A motion was made by Mr. Jason McCray, seconded by Mr. Michael Cheatham, to approve Council on Aging Resolution for Transportation. This motion passed. Mr. Ronald Johnson abstained.

A motion was made by Vice President Chrissie O'Quin, seconded by Mr. Jason McCray, to approve monthly invoices. This motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Jason McCray, seconded by Mr. Ronald Johnson, to approve payment to Traffic Control for guardrails on Mill Creek Lane in the amount of \$16,510.80. This motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Jason McCray, seconded by Vice President Chrissie O'Quin, to accept Planning & Zoning Commission recommendation for approval on Colby Peters plat; Louisiana Land Surveyors; Curtis M. Chaney, Surveyor. This motion passed unanimously with a roll call vote. Mr. Keith Mills was absent.

Ms. Nanette Egros provided an update from East Feliciana Beautiful. Jurors were informed of Education and Recycling Grants. Ms. Egros also informed the Jury that Warden Sanders has agreed to have frames made for the Keep East Feliciana Beautiful signs.

Public Comments were as follows:

- Mrs. Debra Thomas addressed the Jury with concerns of trash pickup in the Village of Wilson. Mrs. Thomas asked if it would be possible to have dumpsters placed at the end of Jefferson Lane, Mathews Lane, and Fort Sholes Lane. She explained because the trash truck does not have a turnaround, resident's garbage is left at the beginning of the road and it has become a litter issue. The Jury asked that Mrs. Thomas try asking the residents to not bring their garbage out until pickup day.
- Mr. John Rouchon informed the Jury that public hearings are scheduled for August 12th at 4pm and August 24th at 5:30pm.
- Mr. John Rouchon asked that the Jury review the Proposed Subdivision Ordinance and set a public hearing date.
- Mr. Richard Oliveaux asked that the Jury become familiar with Solar Farms.
