

The meeting called to order by Chairman O'Quin at 6:53 p.m.

Prayer was offered by Commissioner Bishop and the Pledge of Allegiance was said in unison.

Secretary Rouchon called the roll. Chairman Josh O'Quin and Commissioners Debby Odom, Andy Bishop, Beau Cotton, Martin Macdiarmid, and Matthew Peterson were present. Commissioners Shirley Anderson, and Ashley Ferguson were absent. A quorum was present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Peterson; seconded by Commissioner Macdiarmid to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously without discussion.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bishop; seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve the 10 December Regular Meeting Minutes. The motion carried unanimously without discussion.

Old Business:

a. A motion was made by Commissioner Bishop; seconded by Commissioner Odom to forward the Zoning Ordinance revision recommending to change R-1 minimum lot size to 2 acres. The motion passed unanimously without further discussion.

b. After a brief discussion on the input received from the public, a motion was made by Commissioner Bishop; seconded by Commissioner Peterson to add a gravel alternative and forward the revision to the Police Jury. The motion carried unanimously without discussion.

New Business: Maps advertised & requiring Public Hearings. None.

a. At 1855 a public hearing for the Elizabeth Hughes Haygood map showing survey and removal of: 7.06 acre Tract I-C-B from Tract I-C W.W. After an explanation was provided by the owner and hearing no opposition the hearing was closed at 1857. A motion was made by Commissioner Odom; seconded by Commissioner Peterson to recommend the map for approval. The motion carried unanimously by rollcall vote.
